Wi-Fi Access offers Internet access to users of Verizon Business's Dial Access at public venues, such as hotels, airports, and restaurants. Service options include:

- **Wired (Ethernet).** Internet connectivity via hardwired Ethernet connections in hotel guest rooms
- **Wireless (WiFi/802.11b).** Connectivity to the Internet using Wi-Fi networks in hotel common areas, hotel guest rooms, airports, restaurants, and other venues

## Ease of Use

The integration of Wi-Fi Access into Verizon Business's tools—Enterprise Services Management (ESM) and Access Manager—makes managing remote connections easier than ever.

- Your administrators can utilize our web-based user management tool, Enterprise Services Management.
- Three access possibilities allow your end-users to connect to Wi-Fi Access, regardless of the technology used:
  - **Access Manager.** Wi-Fi Access has been integrated into our Access Manager client, enabling your users to manage and access any of their remote connection options. Access Manager also has a built-in "sniffer" feature to alert users when wireless networks are available for connection.
  - **Access Manager for Windows® Mobile.** Based on Windows Pocket PC 2003, your traveling professionals can preconfigure this client on a PDA device for even more mobility.
  - **Browser-based.** Users can use a common Internet browser to connect to wired locations.

## Features and Benefits

Wi-Fi Access offers a number of features and benefits to Dial Access end-users. They include:

- **Global coverage.** Wi-Fi Access offers you extensive wired and wireless coverage at U.S. and international hotspot locations. There are over 13,000 hotspot locations today—with planned expansion to about 20,000 locations; this ensures your users can continue to connect to important resources almost anywhere business takes them.
- **Hotspot Finder website.** Hotspot locations can be searched via the Hotspot Finder website at [www.verizonbusiness.com/go/hotspots](http://www.verizonbusiness.com/go/hotspots), providing a complete and up-to-date location list:
  - Searchable by country, city/state, zip/postal code, area code, venue, and access method
  - Same look/feel as Verizon Business's PoP Finder.
- **Supplemental access.** Users are only charged when they use Wi-Fi Access services. There are no additional monthly fees for these services.

## Fact Sheet

- **Single bill.** Wi-Fi Access is billed to the corporate customer (not the end-user) on the same invoice as Dial Access; this simplifies the billing process and eliminates extra paperwork.
- **Broadband speeds.** Comparable to a DSL connection, broadband speeds can be obtained with the same Dial Access end-user credentials (username and password) now being used.
- **Customer-managed.** You manage your own end-user accounts, including the ability to control which users can use Wi-Fi Access services, saving you time and administrative costs.
